# WORK OF THE JURY

#### Article 1

- (1) Jury members are teachers whose students participate in the competition. A teacher will participate in the work of the jury in the category in which their student participates.
- (2) The president of the jury, who judges in every category, is elected by the Organizing Committee of the competition from the ranks of prominent pedagogues and music artists from the Republic of Serbia.

## Article 2

# President of the jury:

- (1) Monitors whether the assessment of each jury member is carried out according to the provisions of this rulebook and timely intervenes in cases of deviations, i.e. observed irregularities.
- (2) Upon completion of the Competition category president of the jury submits to the Organizing Committee of the competition a proposal of participants at the final concert.
- (3) At the end of the competition day forms a list with order of competitors' performances at the final concert, along with the list which contains points and the prizes won, and confirms it all with his signature.

### Article 3.

#### Jury members:

- (1) Evaluate the participants with points from zero (0) to one hundred (100).
- (2) Submit individual score lists to the secretary of the jury.
- (3) Enter their grades in the prescribed form and fill it properly.
- (4) Attend the performance of all competitors within the category for which they are responsible.
- (5) Attend jury sessions
- (6) Fill in and sign individual score lists
- (7) Fill in and sign the summary score lists
- (8) Through the president of the jury and the members of the Organizing Committee, they intervene in cases of noticing irregularities in the work and deviations from the Rulebook on the work of the jury.

# Article 4.

A member of the jury cannot evaluate a candidate:

- (1) In case that are related to the candidate
- (2) In case that are a candidates teacher or a professor

#### Article 5.

- (1) The jury's decision is irrevocable and final.
- (2) The decision of the jury cannot be reconsidered, changed and is not subject to appeal.
